## **Jaipur Smart City Limited**



The state government has appointed 2006-batch IAS officer V. Saravana Kumar as the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of the Jaipur Smart City Limited (JSCL).

Kumar, who was serving as Sirohi collector, has been exclusively appointed to execute the smart city works in the state capital.

Kumar's past experience as CEO of the Ajmer Municipal Corporation and as CEO of Kota and Bharatpur zila parishads would come handy for his new assignment. The officer has also served as collector of Dholpur and Baran.

It is informed, the first installment has been released by the Centre for the project, which is Rs 186 crore for Jaipur and the work is about to begin. The JSCL has bifurcated the short-term and long-term projects, which would be initiated under the smart city mission. Some of the short-term projects the company will undertake include Public Bicycle Scheme (PBS), heritage facade, rainwater structures, smart toilets, digital signages.





### **NULM renamed as DAY-NULM**



The government announced renaming of National Urban Livelihood Mission (NULM) as "Deen Dayal Antyodaya Yojana-NULM", which will now cover all 4,041 statutory urban local bodies in the country.

Introduced in 2013, the programme, which will be named as "Deen Dayal Antyodaya Yojana-Rashtriya Shahri Aajeevika Mission" in Hindi, is being currently implemented in 791 cities across the country covering all district headquarters, cities and towns with a population of above one lakh.

NULM seeks to enhance employment opportunities and incomes of the urban poor through skill development and training, setting up of individual and group micro-enterprises, formation of Self-Help Groups, building shelters for homeless, among others.



## Cartist Automobile Art Festival inaugurated in Jaipur



An Automobile Art Festival is being held in Jaipur, Rajasthan, India from April 18-21, 2016.

A week long Cartist Automobile Art Festival is being held at Narain Niwas, Jaipur. It is a residential art workshop which sees 200 budding artists from across the country take part in various workshops and activities related to automobiles.

There will also be special sessions and interaction with well known artists from India. On the 22nd April, all these works will be exhibited in the garden of World Trade Center, Jaipur.

Cartist Automobile Art Festival is an initiative of Jaipur based Himanshu Jangid, a vintage car restorer for royalties. The festival was inaugurated by Chief Minister Vasundhara Raje. It comprises of a total of 10 workshops which are being held that include Calligraphy, Clay Modelling, Art Therapy, Miniature, Caricature, Photography, Street Art, Water Colour, Print and Mono Prints. Cars rule the show where artists are depicting and displaying automobile art be it from funky cars to vintage scooters.







## Stop Over

The Moti Dungri Ganesh Temple was constructed by Seth Jai Ram Paliwal in the early eighteenth century, and continues to be one the most popular tourist destinations in Jaipur. Situated in the heart of Jaipur, the Moti Dungri temple is perched on a small hill, and is surrounded by an exotic palace. In the recent past, the palace was home to Rajmata Gaytri Devi, but now, the palace is locked to public, with the temple being the only tourist location. The highlight of this place is the famous and auspicious temple of Lord Ganesha, which is frequently visited by the inhabitants of Jaipur, and other tourists from around the world. In modern times, it is said that thousands of devotees flock the temple on a daily basis and it is considered to be one of the most important religious structures in Jaipur. The temple is nestled by the beautiful palace, called the Moti Dungri palace, which is an imitation of a popular Scottish castle.
